- Objectives of the Practice
- 1. To raise awareness about the Corona pandemic in the college and nearby community.

The Context

Following are the challenging issues that needed to be addressed in designing and implementing this practice.

The disease started in China and then spread to Europe and America. The disease started spreading in India from March onwards. Covid precautionary scheme started in Maharashtra from 13th March 2020. A curfew was first imposed in Pune city. A nationwide curfew was imposed on March 22. Schools and colleges were closed. Colleges started after the first wave subsided and the college took measures to control Covid 19. Involved in this fight by involving college students. There was a severe shortage of medicines, injections, doctors, beds all over thecountry. The country had to face a big crisis. In the second wave, the condition of the country became very bad. Therefore, control over Covid 19 became a necessity and the college undertook the task of controlling this disease.

• The Practice

It was decided to raise awareness about the disease in the respective villages by contacting thestudent who had participated in the National Service scheme and the National cadet corps in the college to fight the corona epidemic and create public awareness.

The main objective was to create awareness about corona in the minds of people who did notknow much about corona.

The college student was given the responsibility of rising awareness against the Corona epidemic in his own village. The students surveyed each family and checked the temperatureand oxygen level. Told everyone in the family to take care of this.

Evidences of success

Online education was being imparted in the college at the time of Covid's infection. We followed all the rules to prevent the spread of the disease during this period. Therefore, no Covidpatient was found in the college. Although we started teaching offline in the second term, we didnot spread the disease among students and teachers by following all the rules. We asked the students to follow all the rules related to Covid. The college did not have to close due to the outbreak of Covid disease as the students followed the instructions. This is the success of this initiative.

Constraints / limitations

- 1. Shortage Lack of resources: There were acute shortages of Doctor, Medicines, Beds, Oxygen, Ambulance, PPE Kit, Mask, Sanitizer Material etc all over the country.
- 2. Lack of cooperation from the community about social distancing, obeisance of government. Guidelines etc.
- 3. Excesive Fear of the pendamic resulted in not accepting our cooperation by the society.

These online lectures got a good response from thestudents.

Created internet system in college. Provided online teaching training to teachers. Solved many questions of students. And finally the exams were taken online. All the students sat for the exam.
